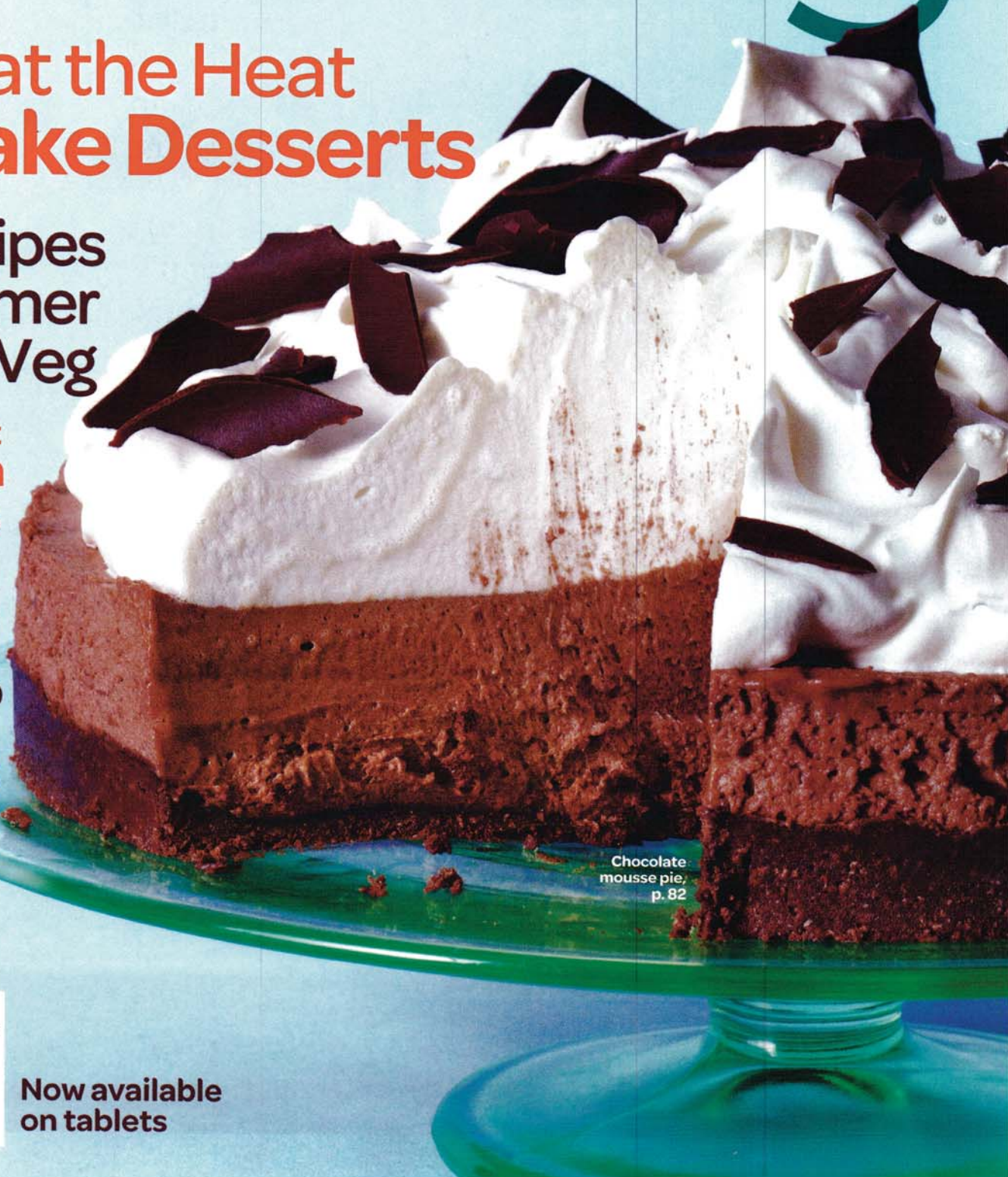

Green Light

We love a refreshing glass of iced green tea, made with Hosen Sencha from Ippodo, a 300-year-old tea grower in Kyoto, Japan. Just steep the leaves in cold water for 15 minutes. The tea is bright, grassy, and, of course, also delicious hot. **\$19.63** for 4 oz.; ippodo-tea.co.jp.



Hip Snips

Some of our favorite products are ones that elevate the look and functionality of an everyday tool, and these stainless steel scissors from Slice do just that. Fill and Chill

Simply run it under water before filling, and as the water evaporates from the unglazed exterior, your drink chills.
